



WHITE TIGER ARCHERY

-GENERAL RULES-

1. General data

- By submitting the registration form for the courses, training sessions and competitions organized by White Tiger Archery, all the rules mentioned below are considered **accepted**.
- White Tiger Archery reserves the right to modify these rules with the mention that any modification will be brought to the attention of the participants on e-mail or on the website whitetigerarchery.ro

2. Personal data

- The personal data that the participants provide in connection to their registration to White Tiger Archery will not be transmitted to other persons or entities, except in cases of force majeure in which, based on the law, this information must be provided to a state institution that requests it.
- White Tiger Archery undertakes to comply with the legislation regarding the **protection of personal data**.
- During practice sessions and competitions, White Tiger Archery may take photographs and video recordings. Participants agree that White Tiger Archery will use these recordings for educational and promotional purposes (media or social media) without owing those who appear in the photos and recordings any money as compensation.

3. Conditions for registration

- The minimum age required to enroll in the courses is 6 years, with the mention that for children and juniors between the ages of 6 and 17, the presence of an adult (parent or tutor) is required for the entire duration of the courses/training.
- Arrival at the range is possible only with prior notification through the available means: e-mail, telephone, filling out the online form available on the website and after receiving the confirmation.



- Registration forms available in pdf format can be completed at home or at the range, but will only be signed at the range, before being handed over to the instructor.
- **White Tiger Archery reserves the right to select the participants.**

4. Services

- White Tiger Archery provides for the participants a range equipped for practicing archery, a locker room and a waiting area.
- The maximum shooting distance is 18m, according to the standards of indoor competitions.
- The equipment is made available only to those who sign up for the beginner courses. For other participants, equipment is available for rent.
- The schedule is displayed on the website and at the entrance to the premises.
- White Tiger Archery reserves the right to change the opening times for objective reasons. In this case, the changes will be announced on the website.

5. Limitation of Liability and Indemnification

- White Tiger Archery is not responsible for the damage of participants' equipment, whether personal or rented equipment.
- In case the participants cause damage to the equipment or to the premises White Tiger Archery will ask them for compensation to cover the damage created.
- Participants are required to notify the instructor if they cause any kind of damage to the equipment or the premises, to prevent accidents that may affect other participants.
- White Tiger Archery is not responsible for personal items left at the premises.
- White Tiger Archery reserves the right to suspend a membership and stop access to training to people who do not comply with the safety rules, without refunding the money for the remaining sessions.



6. Costs

- A.C.S. White Tiger works based on donations and sponsorships.
- For each subscription or training session, as the case may be, a receipt will be issued for the amount paid by the participant.
- Payments can only be made by bank transfer to the association's account or cash at the premises, with the title of donation or sponsorship, and will have the following table as a reference:

7. Safety rules and shooting rules

- Shooters, as well as bystanders, must respect the instructor's directions.
Failure to comply may result in immediate eviction from the shooting range or club.
- It is mandatory to wear appropriate sports equipment (eg without large sleeves).
- For people with long hair, it should be tied back.
- Long earrings are not allowed.
- It is not allowed to participate in the shooting sessions for people with very long nails as serious injuries can occur by pulling out the nails.
- **Attending training under the influence of alcohol and drugs is strictly prohibited.**
- **It is allowed the use of bows of maximum 60 lbs.**
- **The use of crossbows and hunting tips is strictly prohibited.**
- **One will never shoot a bow without an arrow. Serious accidents can occur caused by breaking the bow.**
- **The arrow only goes into the bow when you are on the shooting line.**
- **Positioning on the shooting line will only be done if the range is clear.**
- **Shooting will only be done with the instructor's permission.**
- **A bow must be aimed only at the target. Under no circumstances will the bow, with or without an arrow, BE POINTED AT ANOTHER PERSON.**
- **It is not allowed to change the position of the body once the bow is drawn and it is not allowed to shoot up.**
- Shooting at a target other than the one assigned by the instructor is not allowed.
- If an arrow or part of the shooting equipment has fallen on the way to the target while shooting is in progress, it will NOT be retrieved until after all shooters have completed all arrows to be shot.
- Walking to the target to collect the arrows will ONLY be done after all shooters have finished shooting and only after the instructor has approved.
- If several archers have shot at the same target, they will collect their arrows in turn, being very careful not to injure the person behind them when drawing.
- After collecting their arrows and returning to the shooting line, archers will carry their arrows with the tips pointing downwards and move without running.



- The maximum number of arrows per shot will be established by the instructor, depending on the number of participants, so that there is no long waiting time.
- Archers will withdraw from the shooting line immediately after shooting the last arrow, to make way for the other archers.
- No participant has the right to give shooting instructions to other archers.
- Participants are required to check the condition of their equipment and notify the instructor if anything appears to be wrong. The use of damaged equipment is strictly prohibited.
- Shouting and any other actions that could affect those in the shooting line are prohibited.
- People who do not participate in the shooting must keep a distance of at least 2m from the shooting line.
- **During training sessions, the instructor may touch parts of the archers' body in order to help them improve their shooting position and technique or to avoid injuries.**
- **Participants have the obligation to ensure that their actions do not endanger their health and those around them.**
- **Participants take on their own responsibility all the risks that practicing archery may present.**
